And from the window in the loo

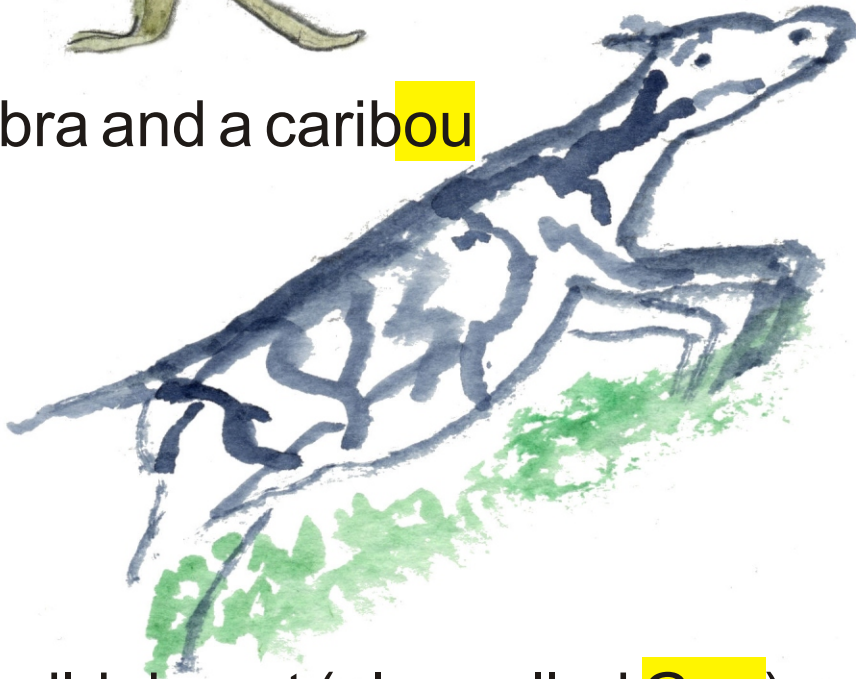
They got a very special view;
